Parents & Students- Here is some information for competition day!

- The Competition is held at CSULB in the music department. The best address is: 6200 E. Atherton St., Long Beach, CA 90815. You will park in lot G12 (the same lot as the Carpenter Center). The main sidewalk has a big sign that says "Bob Cole Conservatory of Music."
- You do need to pay for parking. There are machines that take debit/credit cards and you will need to enter your license plate number.
- Bring your original music and your two filled out evaluation sheets. A copy of the evaluation sheet is below in case you need it.
- Your **specific audition time and room** was given to your teacher. Please reach out to them for this information.
- Plan to arrive at least 20 minutes early and check in at your audition room.
- Wear nice clothes- no crop tops, ripped jeans, tennis shoes, etc.
- Warm up rooms will be available. There is a sign on the ones reserved for Vocal. These are first come first serve. Do not let the door close completely as it may lock on you! There are door stoppers for each room as well.
- The door monitor will escort you into the competition room and introduce you.
 The judges will likely ask you what song you'd like to sing first. You only need to give the title of each song- no need to slate composer, period, translation, etc.
 The judges will also help you with where to stand, etc.
- Once you sing, you may leave if you'd like, or wait until your category closes and results are posted. Results will be posted as soon as they become available both on our website: <u>vo-cal.org/competition-results</u> and on the wall (lower level) facing the Daniel Recital Hall.
- The Awards' Recital will be held at a later date. If you have placed 1st, you will be asked to sing a song in this recital. If you have placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd or honorable mention, you will receive an award (trophies for younger categories and checks for high school and up), so please attend, if you can. All students and families are encouraged to attend this recital regardless of whether you have won. More information will be sent about this recital once the competition ends.
