

Vo-Cal Competition: Rules & Guidelines

Categories:

Classical, Musical Theater & CCM (Contemporary)

Audition Information:

Students will prepare two contrasting pieces. Pieces must be age appropriate.

Accompanist:

Students will provide their own accompanist, or a staff accompanist may be provided upon request, for a fee. Teachers may not accompany their own students.

Teacher duties:

Teachers who have participating students must volunteer on the day of the competition. Teachers may be asked to help in any of the following ways: Check-in, Door Monitor, Adjudicating, Hospitality, Set-up or Clean-up.

Competition Date:

Sunday, May 18th, 2025

Deadlines:

Student Registration: March 18th – April 18th, 2025

Registration is completed on vo-cal.org on the Student Registration page. If you choose a staff accompanist, the fee will be added during registration.

Payment is through Paypal and can be completed once you have registered all students.

Competition Location:

California State University Long Beach

Winners Recital & Prizes:

Winners' recital will be held on Sunday, 6/22 in the Frank Pooler Choir Room at CSULB. First place winners may perform one piece at the recital.

Prizes will be awarded to the top winners in each category.

All students will receive written adjudications of their auditions.
